







WORKSHOP FOR YOUNG RESEARCHERS MIGRATIONS, RULE OF LAW AND EUROPEAN VALUES

For several years, the management of migration flows has been representing one of the main themes of internal and European policies, which might conflict with the values of the Rule of Law and the respect for human dignity, that found the construction of an "integrated" European legal area.

Management of borders, rescue at sea, protection of both substantive and procedural rights, reception and detention, are just some of the aspects that are going to be approached, in both internal and international/European perspective, stimulating the discussion among young, structured and unstructured, researchers (PhD candidates, PhD graduates, Postdoctoral fellows, Researchers) interested in various fields of law.

For this purpose and through this call, the Legal Observatory on the European Area of Freedom, Security and Justice, jointly with the research groups of PRIN "International Migrations, State, Sovereignty and Human Rights: Open Legal Issues" and the Jean Monnet Module "Democracy and Rule of Law: A New Push for European Values (EU-DRAW)" invites young researchers to present and discuss their scientific works within a Workshop that will take place at the University of Salerno in Spring 2023.

How to participate and deadlines

- ✓ Interested young researchers are invited to send, by 15 February 2023, an abstract written in Italian or in English (between 1.500-3.000 words), together with a CV, to the following email address: <u>slsg@unisa.it</u>. Proposals will be selected by the Scientific Committee. The outcome of the selection which is going to be conducted on the basis of the relevance to the themes of the call, the originality and diversity of the subjects will be announced by email no later than 20 March 2023.
- ✓ Selected researchers are invited to hold their presentation at the Workshop, which is going to take place at the University of Salerno, between 20 April and 30 May 2023. Transport costs (up to a maximum of 350 euros) and accommodation costs (up to 2 nights) will be incurred by the organizers.
- ✓ By 30 September 2023 researchers are invited to send the final text of their paper written in Italian or in English (between 6.000-10.000 words), which will be published in paper form and open access by the end of 2023.
